UPDATES ON SCHOOL CLOSURE

- The Government/Department of Education have provided no clear date on the reopening of schools.
- We hear about news relating to reopening in much the same way you do – newspapers, radio + government leaks.
- Indications at the moment from Government/Teacher Unions appear that schools will begin reopening on a phased basis at some point in the future.



SUPPORTING YOUR CHILD AT HOME

- Communicate with the child's teacher.
- Ensure that you try to develop a routine in so far as is possible.
- Encourage them to work independently. Allow them to use copies/paper + then take a picture for Seesaw. Make sure you are checking the work they have submitted on Seesaw.
- Balance school work with wellbeing activities/exercise.
- Focus on reading, phonics, free writing, counting, skip counting, +/-/x/÷ tables.

REMOTE LEARNING IN SCOIL AOIFE

- **Seesaw**

- Endorsed by DDLETB as safest, most child friendly and easiest method of online learning.
- Each day the children get 4 activities to complete.
 - One English.
 - One Maths.
 - One Other (Irish on Tuesday + Thursday).
 - One Exercise/Wellbeing activity.

- **Live Classes on TEAMS**

- Beginning this week with two test calls (Wednesday + Friday).
- After this week the children will have two live classes per week. (Reviewed after two weeks).

- **Resources**

- Paper, Copies, Pens, Pencils, Sharpeners.
- Available to collect in the school on Wednesdays.
- Contact your child's teacher to arrange collection.

LIVE CLASSES ON TEAMS

- Two test calls this week. See timetable.
- Two live classes per week.
- Classes will be between 15 – 25 minutes.
- All live classes will take place on the TEAMS platform.
- The school Code of Conduct applies on these calls. Teachers will be extremely strict with rules/guidelines in order to ensure safety.

LIVE CLASSES ON TEAMS

- Link for classes will be posted as an activity to the children's Seesaw.
- Children will need to click the link at the appropriate time to enter call.
- Children must enter their name correctly in order to be allowed into the call.
- Children must be dressed appropriately + be in safe location for call.
